A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the regulation of plumbing.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 1301.002, Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 by amending Subdivisions (7), (11), and (12) and adding Subdivision
- 6 (8-a) to read as follows:
- 7 (7) "Plumbing" means:
- 8 (A) a fixture, appurtenance, appliance, or
- 9 piping, including a disposal system, used to:
- 10 (i) supply, distribute, circulate, or
- 11 recirculate water, other liquid, or gas; or
- 12 (ii) eliminate sewage for a personal or
- 13 domestic purpose;
- 14 (B) a fixture, appurtenance, appliance, or
- 15 piping used outside a building to connect the building to:
- 16 (i) a supply of water, other liquid,
- 17 medical gases and vacuum, or other gas on the premises; or
- 18 (ii) the main in the street or alley or at
- 19 the curb;
- 20 (C) a fixture, appurtenance, appliance, or
- 21 piping, including a drain or waste pipe, used to carry wastewater or
- 22 sewage from or within a building to:
- (i) a sewer service lateral at the curb or
- 24 in the street or alley; or

- 1 (ii) a disposal or septic terminal that
- 2 holds private or domestic sewage; [ex]
- 3 (D) the installation, repair, service, or
- 4 maintenance of a fixture, appurtenance, appliance, or piping
- 5 described by Paragraph (A), (B), or (C); or
- (E) the installation, repair, and service of
- 7 <u>equipment for rainwater harvesting</u>.
- 8 (8-a) "Rainwater harvesting" means the capture,
- 9 diversion, storage, treatment, and distribution of rainwater from a
- 10 roof structure for landscape irrigation, potable drinking water, or
- 11 nonpotable use for a personal residence or domestic use.
- 12 (11) "Water supply protection specialist" means a
- 13 person who holds an endorsement issued by the board to engage in:
- 14 (A) customer service inspections, as defined by
- 15 rule of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality; and
- 16 (B) the installation, service, and repair of
- 17 plumbing associated with the $\underline{\text{treatment,}}$ use, and distribution use
- 18 of rainwater to supply a plumbing fixture, appliance, or irrigation
- 19 system.
- 20 (12) "Water treatment" means a business conducted
- 21 under contract that requires ability, experience, and skill in
- 22 analyzing water to determine how to treat influent and effluent
- 23 water to change or purify the water or to add or remove minerals,
- 24 chemicals, or bacteria. The term does not include treatment of
- 25 rainwater or the repair of systems for rainwater harvesting. The
- 26 term includes:
- 27 (A) installing and servicing fixed or portable

- 1 water treatment equipment in a public or private water treatment
- 2 system; or
- 3 (B) making connections necessary to install a
- 4 water treatment system.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 1301.053(a), Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A person is not required to be licensed under this
- 8 chapter to perform:
- 9 (1) plumbing incidental to and in connection with the
- 10 business in which the person is employed or engaged if the person:
- 11 (A) is regularly employed as or acting as a
- 12 maintenance person or maintenance engineer; and
- 13 (B) does not engage in plumbing for the public;
- 14 (2) construction, installation, or maintenance on the
- 15 premises or equipment of a railroad if the person is an employee of
- 16 the railroad who does not engage in plumbing for the public;
- 17 (3) plumbing if the person is engaged by a public
- 18 service company to:
- 19 (A) lay, maintain, or operate its service mains
- 20 or lines to the point of measurement; and
- 21 (B) install, change, adjust, repair, remove, or
- 22 renovate appurtenances, equipment, or appliances;
- 23 (4) appliance installation and service work, other
- 24 than installation and service work on water heaters, that involves
- 25 connecting appliances to existing openings with a code-approved
- 26 appliance connector if the person performs the work as an appliance
- 27 dealer or an employee of an appliance dealer; or

- 1 (5) water treatment installations, exchanges,
- 2 services, or repairs, other than for rainwater harvesting.
- 3 SECTION 3. Section 1301.302, Occupations Code, is amended
- 4 to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 1301.302. CONTRACT INFORMATION; REQUIRED DOCUMENTS. A
- 6 written proposal, invoice, or contract relating to plumbing
- 7 services performed by or under the direction of a plumber licensed
- 8 under this chapter must contain the name and license number of the
- 9 responsible master plumber and the name, mailing address, and
- 10 telephone number of the board. The person who performed the
- 11 services shall give the customer an invoice or completed contract
- 12 document on completion of the job, regardless of whether the person
- 13 charged a fee for performing the services.
- 14 SECTION 4. Section 1301.303(a), Occupations Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (a) The board may investigate an alleged violation of this
- 17 chapter by a person who:
- 18 (1) is licensed under this chapter; [or]
- 19 (2) is the owner of a plumbing company subject to this
- 20 chapter; or
- 21 (3) performs plumbing without holding a license under
- 22 this chapter.
- SECTION 5. Section 1301.351, Occupations Code, is amended
- 24 by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 25 (d) A person who holds a license or registration issued
- 26 under this chapter shall carry the license or registration on his or
- 27 her person while engaged in plumbing.

- 1 SECTION 6. Section 1301.357(e), Occupations Code, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 (e) A person is not required to hold a water supply
- 4 protection specialist endorsement if the person[+
- 5 $\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$ is employed by:
- 6 (1) (A) a political subdivision; or
- 7 (2) $\left[\frac{B}{B}\right]$ an electric utility as defined by Section
- 8 31.002, Utilities Code[; and
- 9 [(2) acts as a backflow prevention device specialist
- 10 or water supply protection specialist in the course of the person's
- 11 employment].
- 12 SECTION 7. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 13 services performed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 14 Services performed before the effective date of this Act are
- 15 governed by the law in effect on the date the services were
- 16 performed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 17 purpose.
- SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
