Rainwater Harvesting Rebate Workshop

Understanding Rainwater Harvesting Rebates in San Marcos

On Saturday, June 6, Acer Water Tanks will host a free, informational workshop designed to help San Marcos homeowners and owners of commercial properties understand and take advantage of the city's new rainwater harvesting rebate program, as well as incentives offered by Hays County.

Rainwater harvesting is the collection and storage of rainwater before it runs into streets and gutters. There are many benefits of rainwater harvesting:

- It helps the environment by conserving water and reducing storm water runoff.
- Plants love it! Rainwater is low in dissolved minerals and almost ph neutral.
- It's an alternative water supply, so it's exempt from drought restrictions.
- Rainwater is free! All you have to buy is the collection system.

To encourage rainwater harvesting, the city of San Marcos offers a rebate of up to 50% of the total system cost, including rainwater tanks, screened gutters, leaf screens, first-flush diverters, primary filtration systems, tank pad / foundation, pumps, and backflow devices installed at the city water meter.
