Stewards Individual Placements provides individuals with service and career opportunities to strengthen communities and preserve our natural resources. Stewards, in partnership with the National Park Service, are seeking an intern to serve as Community Volunteer Ambassador.

POSITION DETAILS

- Length: position is 50 weeks, 40 hours/week
- Start Date: Monday, February 7th 2022
- Living Allowance: Baseline allowance of \$500/week*
- AmeriCorps Award: \$6,345 (pre-tax)
- Application Due Date: **12/17/2021**, or Until Filled
- Members will attend a week-long, nationwide, National Early Service Training
- Members will receive Public Land Corps Hiring Authority upon completion

ABOUT THE SITE

Lyndon B. Johnson National Historical Park tells the story of our 36th President beginning with his ancestors until his final resting place on his beloved LBJ Ranch. This entire "circle of life" gives the visitor a unique perspective into one of America's most noteworthy citizens by providing the most complete picture of any American president.

POSITION SUMMARY

The Community Volunteer Ambassador (CVA) intern will be responsible for working and assisting in leading the park's community engagement and volunteer program. Through a series of programs, events, and community outreach initiatives, CVA intern will work alongside park rangers to build a stronger and relevant community presence throughout the Texas Hill Country.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist in building a strong volunteer program by supporting Volunteer Coordinator
- Assist in presenting education and community engagement programs
- Providing creative, relevant, and engaging interpretive experiences for visitors of all ages and different backgrounds
- Lead volunteer service events during National Public Lands Day, National Park Week, MLK Day, and other events

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Enthusiastic, reliable, and responsible
- Great public speaking skills and positive attitude
- An education background in history, political science, education, environmental science, or similar subjects is recommended
- Education: High School diploma/GED required
- Between the ages of 18-30 years old (35 years old if you are a veteran)
- Be a U.S. citizen or lawful permanent resident
- Submit proof of a Driver's License and undergo a Federal Background Check, upon selection
- It is very likely that all participants will be required to be fully vaccinated to serve in the 2022 CVA Program. At a minimum participants will be required to get tested weekly if they are not vaccinated. Dates for implementing these requirements are not yet determined, but we expect that compliance will be necessary by the end of 2021.

- Strong verbal and communication skills
- Experience working in customer service
- Strong computer skills
- Self-starter, creative, strategic, and resourceful
- Comfortable working with large groups
- Proficient in Microsoft Office and social media platforms
- Experience in Adobe products preferred
- Local applicants from the Texas Hill Country, including San Antonio and Austin are preferred
