

ELEVATED HIGHWAYS ARE AN OUTDATED CONCEPT

TxDOT's plan has over a mile of elevated roadway, yet around the world, elevated highways are being torn down to **revitalize** communities and **stimulate** economic growth

- Decrease property values
- Increase light and noise pollution
 More vulnerable to severe weather

 - More expensive to maintain
